## The SCERTS Model and Emotional Regulation:

Addressing Behaviors that Interfere  
with Learning and Social Engagement  
across Developmental Stages

This course will provide an introduction of the SCERTS model followed by a discussion of practical strategies consistent with this model to foster emotional regulation and prevent behaviors that interfere with learning and social engagement across a wide developmental range. The SCERTS Model is a comprehensive, multidisciplinary educational approach designed for children with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD). The model was designed to provide guidelines for helping children progress through the stages of becoming a competent social communicator. It was also designed to provide families and educational teams with the help they may need to feel successful in supporting the child. Families and educational teams will learn about essential interpersonal modifications, environmental arrangement, and visual supports and how they can be embedded in natural functional and meaningful contexts.
